ATO Tax Support

From July to October each year, ATO accredited volunteers help people lodge their tax returns online. Our volunteers can also help you to:

- create a myGov account
- lodge an amendment to your tax return
- claim a refund of franking credits
- tell us if you don't need to lodge a tax return.



You can speak to a Tax Help volunteer:

- online
- by phone
- in person at Tax Help centres across Australia.

Eligibility for Tax Help

You are eligible for Tax Help if your income is around \$60,000 or less for the income year and you didn't:

- work as a contractor for example, a contract cleaner, taxi or uber driver
- run a business, including as a sole trader
- have partnership or trust matters
- sell shares or an investment property
- own a rental property
- have capital gains tax (CGT)
- receive royalties
- receive distributions from a trust, other than a managed fund
- receive foreign income, that is not a foreign pension or annuity.

If you are not eligible for Tax Help, you may qualify for assistance from a National Tax Clinic program.

3 Ingredient Apple Danish

2 apples cored, peeled and quartered 1/3 cup raw caster sugar – plus a little extra for dusting 2 sheets of puff pastry

Method

- 1. Preheat the oven to 220 degrees (200 fan-forced)
- 2. Peel, core & quarter your apples then place them into a medium saucepan with a splash of water and cover & cook over medium heat for 4 mins or until softened. Remove from heat and stir through the sugar, setting aside to cool.
- 3. Cut each pastry sheet in half, then each half into three even rectangles.
- 4. Brush the border of one rectangle with water then add the cooked apple and take another pastry rectangle and cut a few small slits across it, being careful not to cut the whole way across.
- 5. Place the piece over the apple filling, pressing the two pieces of pastry together firmly around the edges to make a parcel.
- 6. Repeat with the remaining ingredients until you have 6 parcels, then place them on an oven tray lined with baking paper. Sprinkle each one with the extra sugar and bake for 12 to 14 mins or until puffed and golden brown.
